Show Site and Food

The show site is indoors on rubber matted surface. Ring size is 60x70. Parking close to building. Limited indoor crating space. Bring chairs and crates. Snacks & drinks will be available or bring snack to share. Please potty your dogs in the designated areas.

Directions to show site

From NJ Turnpike: Take Exit 8 to Rt. #33 east. Make right at Prodelin Way. Continue for approx. 4.4 miles. Road name changes to Perrineville Road then to Sweetmans Lane. Driveway is at top of the hill just after "Somers Court" on left and Tractor Crossing sign. Sign out front "Jack Russell Rd."

From Rt. #9 north or south: In Freehold, take Rt. #33 west to intersection Millhurst Rd. Take that jug handle. (Citco gas station on right) Road name changes to Sweetmans Lane. Go approx. 4.5 miles, Driveway is on right at the top of the hill just after "Chadwick Road" and Tractor Crossing sign. Sign out front "Jack Russell Rd."

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Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. **Title ribbons will be available for all completing a title.**

Obstacle Familiarization: Familiarization on TDAA equipment will be held each day following the general briefing. No food or treats allowed in the ring at any time. Judge's briefing for 1st class will follow.

Warm-Ups: A warm up area consisting of an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors with additional equipment when available.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Dogs may also wear clothing or other adornments unless deemed a safety hazard by the judge.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Eligibility

This trial is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs measuring no more than 20" at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register before running at the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

Trial Entry Information

All pre-entries must be received by 6:00 PM three days prior to date of classes entered, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without the correct fees made payable to N. Lamming. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries **without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date.

Day of show entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$2 per run. **Day of show entries must be given to the secretary no less than 30 minutes before the judge's first briefing.** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Measured Height Divisions

All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. A dog's owner or handler may enter the dog at any jump height desired and will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. A dog may enter a trial at only one jump height. Dogs of the same measured height compete at the same course times, even when the jump heights differ. Dogs of the same measured height compete against each other. Measured height divisions are as follows:

- 4" and under at the withers jumps 2"
- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 16" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 20" and under at the withers jumps 16".

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested or weight-to-height provision) exemption or a veteran (dogs of at least 7 years of age) jump height exemption will be permitted to jump 4" lower and may be granted additional time. However they will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into. Additional time is allowed for disabled handlers if so desired. See www.k9tdaa.com for details.

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Fast Track entries are not accepted at this trial.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show or between classes at this trial. Move up requests must be in writing or may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned

Disabled Handlers

Disabled handlers will receive an additional 4 seconds in the standard course time for the Standard class and in the qualifying course time for some of the Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disabled parking tag or other official documentation provided with the entry or presented at check-in. Proof of disability must be supplied in order to enter as a disabled handler.

Closed (collapsed) Tunnel
Open (pipe) Tunnel

Weave Poles (24" centers)
Single and Winged Jumps
Dogwalk (8'ramp)

Table (36"X36")
Tire Jump (18")
Teeter (8'ramp)

All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements. This is slatted equipment except for the teeter. **Contact a coat is on all equipment**

Games Classes

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing or game description.

Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The first is dog's-choice in which the dog earns the right to score three "colored" obstacles by doing a red hurdle before each. The second part is a simple sequence. Snooker is scored Points, Then Time.

Helter Skelter is a game of speed and skill, played on a numbered course consisting of obstacles arranged in a spiral that builds speed. Helter Skelter is scored Faults, Then Time.

Four-Leaf Clover is a game in which obstacles are arranged in a pattern resembling a four-leaf clover. The dog earns bonuses for performing the leaves of the clover while the handler stays in the middle. Four Leaf Clover is scored Points, Then Time.

Mulligan Stew is a type of gamble that is tied to a specific game. Tonight, it will be tied to Four-Leaf Clover. Within 10 seconds of running Four-Leaf Clover, you must state whether you want to rerun the course. You will not be told if you Qualified in Four-Leaf Clover before declaring Mulligan Stew. The Mulligan Stew score will count as the score toward Qualifying. *Special discounted fee of \$7 to run Mulligan Stew.*

Connect the Dots is a dog's choice point accumulation game. The objective is to handle the dog from dot to dot (the contact obstacles) scoring points on all other obstacles in between. Points for the "in between" obstacles are always at risk, as they'll be lost in case of any fault since the last "dot". Connect the Dots is scored Points, Then Time.

Dare to Double is a dog's-choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course (traditionally the A-frame) as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the A-frame is faulted! The dog must get to the finish obstacle before course time elapses or be penalized. Dare to Double is score Points, Then Time.

Colors is a sequencing game. The handler has a choice of running any one of two or three short courses that are woven together on the field.
